



**“From here to there I need a hand”:
The Experiences of Parents with Young
Children Diagnosed with ASD**



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This presentation will highlight the findings of a multiple case study of parents with children deemed at-risk for developmental delays or disabilities and who received early intervention services through the Infant Development Program of BC. The findings focus on the perceptions and experiences of one of the families whose two children received ASD diagnoses by the time they entered the school system. Recommendations for early intervention and support practices in child development reflect the voices of participant parents and of the case family in particular.
